to improve attendance wherever we can. More information about the impact of absence can be found here Why is school attendance so important and what are the risks of missing a day?









CHILD SAFETY AT EASTER

Mini Eggs can pose a serious choking hazard to young children, as they are just the right size to block a child's airway,

meaning they can be incredibly hard to dislodge if it becomes stuck. Unlike grapes which are a similar size and shape, mini eggs are not easy to cut into smaller pieces.

The Child Accident Prevention Trust (CAPT) have advised that parents may want to crush the mini eggs with a pestle and mortar or rolling pin. Alternatively, they said parents may want to opt for a different treat altogether as larger, hollow Easter eggs are much safer.
