## SCHOOL CROSSING

We are aware that since the school entrance has changed, a lot of pedestrians are crossing the road before they reach Karen and some are crossing behind her. This is confusing for road users, and where people cross behind Karen, very dangerous as she cannot always see people behind her. Please make sure you cross with Karen to keep everyone safe.

## ENGINE IDLING

We have noted that some parents are leaving their engine running on the new car park. Idling, instead of turning your engine off while stationary, increases the amount of exhaust emissions in the air. These contain a number of harmful gasses including carbon dioxide, which is bad for the environment and contributes towards climate change, as well as a range of other harmful gasses which are linked to asthma and other lung diseases. Rule 123 of The Highway Code states that drivers must not leave a parked vehicle unattended with the engine running or leave a vehicle engine running unnecessarily while the vehicle is stationary on a public road. Please can we ask that all parents switch off their car engine when stationary in the car park.

## DEEP ENRICHMENT DAYS



This year, within our DEEP schools, we have introduced a programme of enrichment days. Each school hosts a number of these sessions and we invite two children from every school to take part. So far, pupils have enjoyed Drama, Music, Wellbeing, STEM, Debating and many more exciting themes!
