### THE HIDDEN DANGERS OF PINTEREST - WHITE HATTER

Pinterest often flies under the radar. Unlike platforms such as Instagram or TikTok, it has not attracted the same level of public concern and is often viewed as a harmless, image-based platform.

However, this perception can be misleading. The White Hatter, a Canadian digital safety organisation, recently shared a blog post after supporting two families whose children had shared intimate images using Pinterest's direct messaging feature. In both cases, parents were unaware that the platform even included a messaging function.

Many platforms marketed as creative or visual tools – such as Pinterest, VSCO, Tumblr, Lemon8, Canva and Amino – can include hidden or less-obvious communication features. Parents and carers may find this short, practical article helpful:
