VANDALISM

We were very disappointed to discover that individuals had broken into our school site over the weekend. We suspect that this may not be the first time such an incident has occurred.

The matter has been reported to the police.

To help prevent further incidents and to ensure that any future damage or vandalism is recorded, we have decided to install security cameras around the site. These cameras will be active when staff are not on site. The system will send an alert if anyone enters the premises outside of normal operating hours, enabling us to contact the police immediately. Any footage of unauthorised access, damage, or vandalism will be provided to the police to assist with their investigations. We hope these measures will help protect our school and deter any future incidents. If anyone has any information about this please pop into the office or feel free to contact the police directly.

MUSIC ACTIVITIES THIS SUMMER - BOOKINGS NOW OPEN

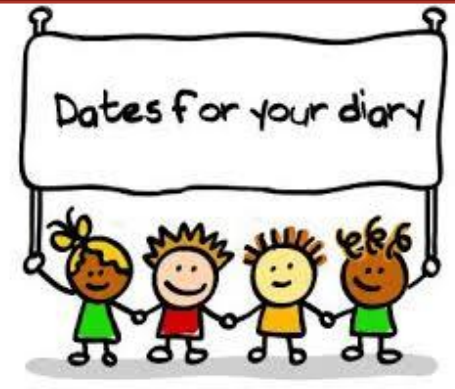
Families are invited to sign up for a range of music activities taking place across Essex this summer. The summer programme includes:
