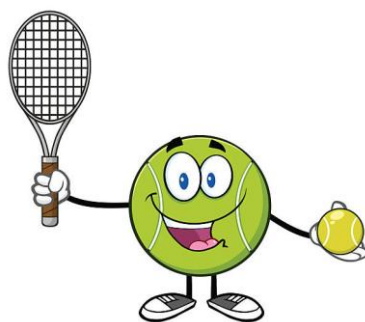
### BIRCH TREE IN THE NEWS!

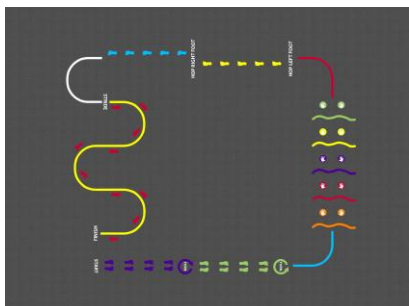
### TENNIS TASTER DAY

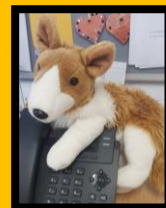
### PARENT MEETING
